COALITION UPDATES: 925am

- Spoke to **ASFP** - Sanborn unable to take it on at this time. Plaistow will do the program at the library on 11/9/21 at 330pm - kids can come over from Pollard; parents will sign kids up through library)
- **Back to School Resiliency Day** - not well attended, but benefited those who did attend by giving materials; kits are still available to disperse. The partnerships (Exeter Hospital, CORE, CLM, Public Health, LOA) were great to work with.
- **In The Air** graphic novels are on hand - Sanborn wellness classes are able to use them beginning in November. Hampstead Middle School can use this in 8th grade health classes
- **Community Assessment Survey** - currently at 64 responses. SoRock members should continue to share out. Kingston will be asking for this info for their Warrant Article
- **PACE Membership** - should we keep it at \$125/yr? It has been helpful this year (with Staples)
- **Red Ribbon Week** - assemblies for 7 /8/9; materials for elementary (Newton and Kingston students)
- **Trade Fair** - in conjunction with Public Health and Sanborn to happen... its so important to show kids all avenues
- **Staying Connected with Your Teen - Starts 10/19 at Plaistow Y** available to families; distributed through Sanborn and Timberlane school
- **Drug Take Back Day** - Charlotte will coordinate supplies; 7 towns participating;

SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:15AM

- SoRock has received a lifesaving bridge grant from NH Charitable Foundation for 20k; we are able to now focus on the Town Warrant Articles that will be coming up soon
- Charlotte has been following up on the Mark Whalberg grant for 10k - she has not returned communication just yet
- We have received word that we are on the Plaistow warrant article / no word from Atkinson
- ****We MUST** have 25 current Kingston residents sign - please be working on this
- Currently working on a small tobacco grant with the state
- Currently exploring Promising Futures grant and whether or not we will be able to apply; may be a quick turnaround, so we should be prepared to act fast to coordinate the grant (substance misuse focused)

PROJECTS AND CAMPAIGNS: 925am

- Possibility to partner with Dover Youth 2 Youth to do mentoring / PSA's
- Can we help support schools to establish after school youth groups?

- **Hampstead Middle School** - they are their own independent SAU 106 now! This may be a good time for SoRock to reconnect with Hampstead; they are planning RRW activities with a known DEA Agent to them
- **TRHS** - Requests are out for LOA kids; Training on 11/8 to happen - NHIAA and Ropes Course combination for the students; SoRock to come in and help with Reality Wall and other lunchroom activities; Great American Smokeout to happen again - making goodie bags to include My Life My Quit info
- **Sanborn - Project Manager for System of Care Grant** there - Karen doing district level meeting to look at multi level tiers of supports
- **Camp Lincoln** - 1st ever homeschool program / theme days for outdoors / leadership club has re-started with about 40 kids
- **Amy (YMCA)**- special events going on but nice weather may have kept people home; Trunk - Or - Treat happening 12 - 230 this Saturday
- **Doug / Lions** is working in Manchester - home opening / keynote speaker
- **Beacon** - staffing and attendance have been hit hard for behavioral health
- **Jane - Hampstead Academy** is open to receiving information; possibly advertise Staying Connected to them for sharing
- **Public Health** - preparing for RRW and Take Back - graphics created with Upper Room; have worked with Pinkerton as well
- **Seacoast Public Health** has hired a person! They should be on board soon.
- **TRMS** - partnering with the high school to train students for LOA; if we were to get the tobacco grant we could use this group for information dissemination
- ****If membership can help spread the word for what SoRock does and how they've been impacted by SoRock on social media and other outlets by all the members and not just Charlotte can be SO HELPFUL!!**
