- The funding from the State continues to be in progress have not yet received any monies yet for the former DFC coalitions (we can use this to fund infrastructure)
- Youth Well New Hampshire offered mini-grants we requested 8500 for Screenagers / Gizmo / Parent Handbooks they are in the process of talking with SoRock for more information; we won't know until the end of January
