<ul> <li>Sanborn the only district to participate in YRBS (no TRSD or Pinkerton)</li> <li>Seacoast Health Mini Grant - will be used to sustain Power Packs</li> <li>South Central Public Health - Creating a micro website for folks to access Power packs (Narcan &amp; Locking med box, Deterra)</li> <li>Nalox Box installed in Sandown - Charlotte misquoted in the article, but the publicity is good; in talks with Atkinson and Danville to install, with Hampstead a possibility</li> <li>Marijuana Legislative Luncheon - well attended; folks were able to learn; did not get passed in Senate (which was good)</li> <li>NH Voices - happened at SRHS (went well) but canceled at TRHS with hopes to reschedule</li> <li>Growing Connections - Earth Day intergenerational bonding contest. Winner from Danville!</li> <li>Connor's Climb Virtual Hike - has been a great collaboration to get folks moving and stepping on stigma; raffles include an EMS gift card, 4 hours at the YMCA, collecting photos and prizes</li> </ul>

- SRHS 25 people showed for Lynne Lyons regarding Anxiety
- **DEA Takeback** on 4/22/23 collected well over 400 lbs of medication
- Safe Prom on May 9 to speak to students about expectations, safety tips and social hosting; Good Samaritan Law
- **Gizmo** will be bringing Gizmo to 2nd grade at Hampstead Central School (feelings / trusted adults / mental health plan / activities) on /; then repeating it at Sandown North and Danville (1st and 2nd grade); the reach will be about 400 kids in 2 days
- Staying Connected to Your Teen was postponed due to only 2 sign ups; looking to reschedule to fall at start of school
- Anxious Nation Screening at the Plaistow Public Library on 5/22/23 showing anxiety in our youth and offering skills; in conjunction with CLM (funded by NH Charitable Foundation & Endowment for Health); Tim, Kelley, & Jess to panel
- Stand By Me is back!! Fremont is not included this year for the 5<sup>th</sup> graders (parents with Charlotte, kids to Camp Lincoln) need a speaker Jeff Levin??

- In the budget for 40k per year for existing coalitions on HB2 (same level as federal funding but will take anything)
