SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:10AM

- Sponsorship with Exeter Hospital for more Power Packs and possibility for more to address senior population in January.
- \$250 from Kennebunk Savings to help with power packs as well, would have been more but they have no location in our towns.
- Youth Well new non profit organization offering small grants to schools and community organizations proposal for \$8500 to support more screenings of Screenagers, parenting materials and some Gizmo book support
- Town Funding Atkinson is asking SoRock to be a Citizens Petition our support from them is questionable; we are asking for all hands on deck to collect signatures of registered voters in Atkinson
- 50K from the State Budget is in the contract phase and expected to be released soon (reimbursement model)
- Bruins Jersey raffle is under way...
- Partnering with SCPHN to do a gift card drive through early December
- Danville in budget; Fremont in budget; Plaistow in budget; Kingston may be reduced amount but in budget; Newton in Human Services warrant; Hampstead warrant article (anticipated town support) standard return to the warrant after 3 years.
