SoRock Updates		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Life of an Athlete</b> training prompted a senior to push it for the whole school to see at TRHS – we can offer up to 3k people; this student also brought it to NHIAA where SoRock will be “hired” on Feb 1, 2021 to facilitate the training for NHIAA members</li> <li><b>Town Safety Kits</b> – being assembled – possible photo opportunity with PD’s right before voting</li> <li><b>Charlotte</b> – SoRock partnered with other DFC/former DFC’s throughout the state on marijuana awareness social media campaign.</li> <li>Scheduling <b>TI trainings</b> (already paid for) – varied topics – looking at scheduling one for Feb as it’s Teen Dating Awareness month</li> <li><b>Social Media Campaign</b> – Be Safe With SoRock – still needs to be completed; reach out to Charlotte</li> </ul>	
Community Updates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agency</li> <li>School</li> <li>Community</li> </ul>	Team	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NHIAA Speaker Series is available – Tim &amp; Kelley facilitated The First Day last month</li> <li><b>NH National Guard – Purple Star School</b> invitations going to kick off soon – about 25 schools to receive the stipend (but any school can join); Joint Military Task Force is working closely with YMCA’s to help work with military families; working with Londonderry High school; also working with Windham HS on their campus radio station initiative</li> <li><b>Camp Lincoln</b> – staff recruitment; registration; winter fest event for community</li> <li><b>TRHS</b> – The First Day reschedule will happen on 2/10/21</li> <li><b>Governor’s Commission</b> – prioritized a number of strategies to include Student Assistance Programs (will approve \$1.2 million to support); request in for Mental Health First Aid training to run on-site</li> <li><b>YMCA</b> – plugging along with learning pods and adjusting accordingly; care during school vacation week; working on camp / enrolling; each school may have up to 25 scholarships</li> <li><b>CLM</b> – new substance abuse group facilitated by two case managers 18+; NARCAN training &amp; SMART recovery later in the year; crisis response&amp; eating disorders on the rise;</li> <li><b>Beacon</b> – the insurances can be complex due to silos of behavioral health and substance; internally launched Project Echo for folks to reach subject matter experts</li> <li><b>Public Health Network</b> – monies available for young adult to take on a mentorship role</li> <li><b>Seacoast Public Health Network</b> – Legislative Breakfast was cancelled but the goal is to still share with legislators the materials anyway – local providers helping out to share points</li> </ul>	
Sustainability & Budget Report	Team	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No updated budget as SERESC was assisting in submitting a grant</li> <li>Applied for the <b>Mental Health First Aid</b> grant at \$125 x 5 years – letters of commitment received from many partners in support of this grant</li> <li><b>Town Funding</b> – in budget for Atkinson (5k) – thanks to Jane K for attending to make sure this went in for this amount (was going to only be 1k); Danville in budget through Human Services (4k) but the deliberative is in July; Fremont we are a WA (\$4750); Hampstead is in budget for (\$8657) – we need to keep our presence known here!!; Kingston had support from residents; Budget Committee wanted to cut funds but we have Selectman support so a WA for \$6333. Newton WA for \$4936 but part of Welfare line, so promising; Plaistow has decided not to support SoRock – we could have done a WA, but followed their guidance to do it differently this year, but they said we did not support Plaistow citizens specifically; Sandown is in for \$1500; NEW: Sanborn Regional School District 3k... could be up to 21 in budgets, 16 in Warrant Articles – could range from 28 – 38k coming our way....</li> <li>Spent all GOFFR funds appropriately; general funds will carry us through town funding</li> </ul>
