COALITION UPDATES: 915am

- **In The Air** graphic novels are on hand - Sanborn wellness classes are able to use them beginning in November. It will reach about 115 students;
- **Gizmo** will be held at Plaistow Public Library... will reach out to other libraries as well; Jane can explore the Atkinson library - this is a focus for kids age 7-10
- **Red Ribbon Week** - awards and gift cards to kids / classroom activities - pizza parties to winning rooms / TRHS Peer Outreach facilitated awareness activities; TRHS also did a Reality Wall (discussing the impact) and sold Aroma Joes' coffee as a fundraiser to raise over \$300 for Lazarus House; 2 assemblies at SRHS - "One Trusted Adult" and Laurie Warnock for gr 7-10; Hampstead had active DEA agents there during the week to talk with students (they are also participating in the Youth Summit and will have Laurie Warnock come again)
- In partnership with South Central Public Health - delivered **Healthy Me** kits to 3rd and 4th grades
- **Trade Fair** - Feb 2, 2021 - to highlight potential career paths out there other than college; TRHS had something similar with Portsmouth Naval Base - it was well received
- **Staying Connected with Your Teen** at Plaistow YMCA - 5-6 parents attending
- **Drug Take Back Day** -475 pounds collected!
- **DEA Award Recipient** - recognized Charlotte for the efforts of SoRock and all the work she has done

SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:08AM

- Updated budget received from SERESC... overall we have a little over 21k full budget
- We **MUST** have cooperation in reaching out to the towns - we **NEED** help with Atkinson and signatures for Kingston
- We are in Danville / Hampstead budgets; will remain in Sanborn's budget this year / (also supportive of the SAP position)
- Plaistow - we are a Selectman's Warrant Article - 1st time ever!!
- Sandown - may reduce us to \$1500 / Fremont - Citizen's Petition Warrant Article / Newton - in Human Services Warrant
- Should we contact Carriage Town News to highlight us for stories through March?

- **Bob Fagan** - offering a lot of support for young people; recovery; alternative suspension - they have transportation waivers that parents sign; Bob operates out of Newton;
- **SRHS** - looking to create student and instructor focused surveys to see how we are doing in teaching skills / SEL through advisory pieces; Zack is creating groups, and meeting the kids.. Getting things going as he is new!
- **TRMS** - LOA Training has happened with high school students; GSA group is running strong
- **YMCA** - Giving Thursdays - the Y's are open for families; annual gala coming up on 11/18/21 - it is virtual (financial support for the Y); the Giving Tree is happening as well (non-perishables and clothing items for families / kids); annual Business After Hours (dodgeball tournament - bring in an item for the Giving Tree)
