- **Town Updates** for 2023- every town we are in budget except Atkinson. We have 40 signatures to back a warrant article and was submitted the day before the deadline. Will be reaching out to supporters in Atkinson.
- **Deliberative Sessions;** On February 4, 2023 Volunteers are requested to attend even in towns where funding seems secure.

The “graduated” DFC’s put in a proposal for funding at the previous federal amount of \$125K/year, which only came out to \$650K request, which is a small ask in for large return as it relate to full State Budget.
