Will show "Fatal Reality" on 5/21</li> <li><b>DOE</b> – is offering TOT for Youth Mental Health First Aid – Tim can forward the info</li> <li><b>Governor's Commission</b> – gearing up for next strategic plan – working on focus groups to get the perspective on how programming is working</li> <li><b>Public Health Network</b> – will follow up</li> <li><b>Seacoast Public Health Network – Growing Connections for Earth Day</b> – working on winners!</li> </ul>
