## **COALITION UPDATES: 915am**

- Chris Goodman works at Children's Hospital in Boston would like to "intern" with us to help with marketing for coalitions and outreach to promote SoRock to make sure folks understand how a coalition works and the funding issues
- Prom Updates good training on Samaritan Law / Overdose / Social Hosting
- Gizmo went to Hampstead / Danville / Sandown kiddos received Gizmo; 1st and 2nd grades; schools are receptive to more
- Virtual Climb such a success
- Anxious Nation Screening great partnership between CLM & SoRock grandparent aged folks well represented (almost 40 people) and multiple towns; Create a series with Resilience and The First Day?
- Sanborn's Project Stand By Me students to Camp Lincoln and parents to SoRock for risk / protective factors; the day went really well discussed substance misuse prevention and kids/parents got to do activities with their parents; kids got drawstrings and parents got parent packs
- Senior Power Packs CScott attended a meeting where seniors were talking about how to get information out to them
- Plaistow Old Home Day CScott will go (if it's not raining :)
- Working with Sanborn on a proposal called **Getting to the Y** (about the YRBS) regarding students taking ownership of the stats
- LockBoxes / Trigger Locks / Doterra available to Newton / Kingston / Fremont
- **Derry Cam** willing to show sites where information will be available (kits / resources)

## SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:07AM

- No word on STOP Act as of yet no word likely till early fall (would be 60k/year for 3 years)
- Waiting on Danville check; Fremont anticipated in July; Hampstead, Plaistow, and Kingston sent check; Newton has temp people so they are working on it; Also will get 3k annual stipend from SRHS
- In the budget for 40k per year for existing coalitions on HB2 (same level as federal funding but will take anything) SoRock is hopeful that it made it in the Senate portion of the bill (EZarka can look into it for SoRock)
- Local organization Evan's Gift -has decided to dissolve and will gift SoRock their money (\$900 for shirts for virtual hike) and potentially 3k more coming they were supposed to meet in June
- Opioid abatement commission has received settlement money (separate from State money) not in the SoRock catchment but will pass along to SCPHN to see if Kate can get some of the money
- AFSP and SoRock are looking to partner for a grant for Gizmo books (funding is 50k)
- Fundraiser in Atkinson is still on! Aim is for August to host a country eventt

## **PARTNER UPDATES: 955 am**

- Governor put out a statement on **marijuana legalization** Eliza will be working on a legalization effort across the country to look at what state control could look like; the governor is not willing to bend on state control to avoid no youth messaging and not taxing it;
- New Futures the legislators voted last week with excellent results on the budget where the **Alcohol Fund was approved** at a 5% of gross liquor profits which helps our substance use disorder prevention, treatment, and recovery. Feel free to contact Janet at jhunt@new-futures.org.
- SPHN- still waiting on budget information; working on end of year fiscal
- CLM Concert event coming up in July; Ginger Zee event just happened; HOPE Program for Children's Program folks specifically trained in first episode psychosis treatment (older teens and younger adults)
- TRHS working with Athletic Director to develop / train leadership in other districts; would the Athletic Directorship take on LOA
