COALITION UPDATES: 925am

- 988 projects have been completed
- First Responder Training – over 30 fire fighters and EMT’s wee trained – very well received and will possibly become part of the new recruit training (with Deb Pendergast);
- Regulated Classroom training – happened in June – approximately 30 participants and well received
- Student Assistance at SRHS – Charlotte helped HLeavitt complete an application for a grant extension for more money for SAP
- Plaistow Old Home Days – successful in handing out medicine cabinets and displaying mental health signs from students
- Red Ribbon Week preparation to happen in September / October

- STOP Act Grant submitted in June – they are still reviewing
- SoRock has been paid from all town funders and PHN’s
- Exeter Hospital is not doing grants this year, but is sponsoring projects and possibly will support the “Power Packs”

- MReyes – **Public Health Network** - waiting for funding to come from state but given the new work plans – working with Exeter hospital to address medication safety with the elderly and falls prevention and 988 – Kudos given to charlotte for doing such a good job on the reports
- **YMCA** – summer camps have been going strong; got money for middle schools to use memberships and maybe an outing for TRMS 7th graders; the Governor is coming next Wednesday as they are hosting the Governor’s Council meeting
- **SRHS** – Jen Mitchinson is the new Principal
- **CLM** – turnover has been frustrating; they have seen an increased need for kids aged 5 and younger; also continue to see substance use / marijuana use in teens – they feel like its their only option
- **TRHS** – Advanced Life of an Owl training with upperclassmen last week – ropes course and team building; new AP Danielle Foley came to observe
- **Angels of Addiction** - reaching out to new places for exhibits – Plaistow and Atkinson library (who declined – Jane

may be able to help with advocating so they understand); also Dartmouth Hitchcock but it's a 2 year wait

- **PHN** - coming back from maternity leave; looking to collaborate with Charlotte; Narcan with Derry EMS; public health volunteers to get Narcan ed
- **National Guard** - – fall looks busy – strategic communications planning for coalitions is a priority right now; new MOU with state police and HITDA; he is also working on overdose mapping to be able to watch the area for us
