COALITION UPDATES: 9:15am

- **Governors Youth Advisory Council** - Two advocates applied from our catchment. One Sanborn & one Timberlane.
- **NH Teen Institute** - SoRock Sponsoring Staying Connected with your Teen with Teen Institute at the Plaistow Y. Distributed to all schools and via social media.
- **Screenagers Movie** - Two most recent movies to be shown. Addressing Mental Health and Substance Use - 1 hr movies sponsored by the South Central PHN and Sanborn HS - hoping for Oct dates at the PAC and Sanborn.
- **LOA Leadership Summit**- 11/6 Regional Leadership Training with Deb Hult. Inviting 5-6 students from all High Schools in the region.
- **LOA Training on 10/25 “Expansion Training”** to create new slides that are more inclusive of all kids not just athletes that can be rolled out at leadership summit
- **SoRock has a new resource card** - let us know if you need some!
- **SoRock can help with Red Ribbon Week** - goods, contests, speakers etc SoRock has materials from the South Central PHN for all the elementary schools in it’s catchment.
- **Gizmo** - last year educated about 600 kids with mental health materials; would like to target Pollard, Atkinson, Ellis; will also be working on streamlining the delivery and training facilitators
- **Children Deserve Recovery Too (NCOA)** - Charlotte and Kelley will go to an orientation to learn more about what they offer
- **Kate McDonald went to the CADCA training** and brought back materials that Charlotte attended the Danville Old Home Days and handed out books about addiction for kids - the town reception was fantastic
- Fingers crossed that Kelley gets a CADCA scholarship to attend (Charlotte and Kate hope to go funded by SCPHN)
- Charlotte attended the week long New England Best Practices School to update training.

SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:07AM

- SoRock did not receive the STOP Act Grant, (No NH Awards)
- SoRock continues to gear up for warrant articles in each town - Charlotte has submitted an ‘impact statement’ to each town for them to review the efforts in each community in addition to requests for funding and any required town documents.
- Governor's Budget - five coalitions were put in at 40k each but one coalition declined so 200k may be split between the 4
- Donations - Jane’s daughter sent in \$20 of her own money
- \$500 from Atkinson Lions Club to help pay for half of the band at Saddle Up Saloon for the 9/29 fundraiser (raffles included)
- asking for donations to help with raffle baskets

- **New Futures** - The bill to legalize marijuana failed; Alcohol Fund was fully funded this year (11 million dollars); Medicaid reauthorized for 7 years; this is a lot to celebrate for NH but the work continues. It is extremely helpful to hear from the voices of NH. Lots of staff turnover, will appoint a new SoRock rep.
- **Hampstead Middle School** - preparing for Red Ribbon Week by bringing in the Andover DEA; may do a 'career fair' for the students. Will consult with SoRock and Sanborn Career Pathways program on their career fair.
- **Ellis School** ran the LEAD Program but had some issues and may not run it this year due to being a poor match for the community. Will set up a meeting with Charlotte to discuss Gizmo with the admin.
- **Laurie Warnock** may be available for 6th grade / middle school presentations for vaping. Book soon for RRW
- **Ben Williams from State Liquor** - doing a lot of training for licensees; compliance checks, available for career fairs. Has mobile safety trailer for schools for education
- **CLM** - 7 Challenges is in need of members (teen) as a small group. is running now.
- **Kim Gordon** - their parent company has some leftover funds and she will try to nominate SoRock to receive it
- **Angels of Addiction** - almost 300 portraits in the community for the month of september, may bring some to our fundraiser to display.
- **Jane Kowalski** - has some former school board reps interested in putting something together to air on the Atkinson cable network. Suggested reaching out to family court with resources.
- **Rick Frost** - Offering fly overs and programming for RRW. Will meet with Charlotte separately to discuss
- **SRHS** - club fair at Sanborn; may get a grant to have youth unpack the YRBS data "getting to Y"; continuing middle school youth group
- **SRMS** - SoRock putting together backpacks for 7th grade team building at camp Lincoln this month with materials funded by Seacoast PHN grant.
- **TRMS** - 6th graders are involved with Camp Lincoln right now
- **South Central PHN** - Working on Getting to Y into the Pinkerton, State rolled out new "Strong as Granite" campaign and materials will be distributed when available.
