COALITION UPDATES: 925am

- **Town Advisory Committee** – we need members so please get the word out!
- **American Suicide Prevention Foundation** – had a large adult representation but we may need to target youth (attendance low)
- **Talk Saves Lives** – discussed 988 and ICare to inform about mobile access points beginning in July; this event was widely publicized but poorly attended; another Talk Saves Lives presentation in Plaistow where attendance will be preregistered to see if it can proceed (May 9, 2022)
- **PACE Mental Health Breakfast** – to happen on May 19 – can talk about Talk Saves Lives there to reach the audience

SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:10AM

- **Grant Opportunities** – not a lot of grants for us to apply for right now...
- **WE HAVE BEEN FUNDED BY ALL 8 TOWNS FOR THE FIRST TIME!!** This is exciting news as we've worked hard on this for many years now. The purpose is to gain interest in each town to help the coalition.

- **No Current Updates**

PARTNER UPDATES: 945am

- **TRSD** – Tim and Kelley did suicide prevention training for paraeducators and other TRSD staff on another PD day – it received good reviews! Outreach overall for 988 info has reached approximately 600 people;
- **tMFHA** – Tim and Kelley were able to train 6 individuals from TRHS to become mental health first aiders!
- **SRMS** – Youth In Action – collected positive messaging from peers to distribute to the school
- **SRSD** – Art Department repurposing the yard signs to ICare messaging – Charlotte talked to about 90 kids about 988 and rapid response; Zack completed SOS for grades 7 & 9; looking to do a DBT curriculum for next year to address mental health and resilience skills
- **YMCA** – exploring training opportunities for communities and their youth groups
- **ICare brochures** – available to be distributed!! Charlotte did a great job merging all of the info
- **First Responder Training** – is being organized by the public health networks – many departments are already signed up
- **Regulated Classroom** – Tim is trying to coordinate a training of trainers – stay tuned!
- **Beacon** – no new updates; the behavioral part is being acquired by Anthem, so that may open up providers and accessibility
- **Seacoast Public Health** – welcome Sam!
- **Angels of Addiction** – Jim & Ann Marie were interviewed for an article in the Concord Monitor
