PROJECTS AND CAMPAIGNS: 1000am

- OD Kits ready for all 8 police departments
- DEA Take Back Day is October 29th, SoRock will pick up supplies at DEA in Bedford after this meeting.
- A community forum to discuss the wellbeing of youth in our communities is tentatively planned for November with Jeff Levin of the Reconstruction project and Former Chief Justice John Broderick hopefully at the YMCA.
- SoRock is planning a Youth Action Summit November to include grades 8-12 from Timberlane, Sanborn, Ellis, Hampstead MS and Pinkerton (maybe). The summit will take place at the Austin 17 House and will be facilitated by Teen Institute. Approximately 8 students from each school will attend. Timberlane HS will pay for TI, SoRock will work to secure funding for stipend for A17 and facilitator for the community forum (\$300)
- Community Power Packs, most packets are on hold pending arrival of the check from Exeter Hospital. The bags were ordered early and have arrived. PD OD prevention kits to be transferred to new bags during Sanborn Senior activity.
- Synar Tobacco Compliance certificates (South Central) have been distributed to PHN's by BDAS and SoRock is working on a distribution plan with South Central. Will follow up with Seacoast PHN after meeting to discuss further.
- Gizmo is planned for November at Sanborn Memorial in Newton. Approximately 200 3rd and 4th grade students will experience the Gizmo program. This will hopefully be a model for bringing it in to our other elementary schools.

PARTNER UPDATES: 945am

- **Seacoast Public Health Network** – Assets and gaps survey sent out to stakeholders. Synar certificates also received for region.
- **AFSP** – LGBTQ Night Out Bowling event. Ages 16-24, please continue to promote. AFSP may have funds to help sponsor SoRock events related to mental Health. Working on Gizmo with Charlotte for Newton Memorial School.
- **SRHS** – Community Service opportunity during PSAT, students will put together OD prevention power packs for PD's. Sanborn has lots planned for red ribbon week.
- **CLM** – Outreaching to schools for support. Hosting open house Wednesday evening geared toward first responders and school admins. Capacity reached with invited guests. Attendees will learn more about rapid response and emergency services.
