COALITION UPDATES: 9:25am

- Jillian Burns is with Seacoast MH – school liaison – will help support the integrated services between Seacoast Mental Health and the schools (supporting Sam Horrigan) and carrying a small caseload for Tier 1 and II kiddos; also supporting Raymond; she will also conduct PD trainings for the districts (mental health)
- **PACE Breakfast** – happened on 5/19/22 at SRHS with presentations from ASPF/988
- **Teen Mental Health First Aid Training** – happened at SRHS in May – great group of students
- **First Responder Training / I Care Model** – ensuring first responders are taking care of themselves too (Responder 911) – available to all of the PD and FD in the region for a lunch and learn; 2nd date of 6/27/22 for South Central Network
- **Regulated Classroom – TOT** – to be held at Austin 17 to be held 6.21 & 22 – 1k cost but available for free to educators
- **Trying to meet people where they are at** – SoRock is looking to jump on others bandwagon instead of creating our own to have a reach for the community
- **Plaistow Old Home Day** – on 6/18/22 on the Common – Charlotte needs help on 6/17/22 for set up and take down on the 18th

SUSTAINABILITY AND BUDGET REPORTS: 9:10AM

- Still waiting for checks from two towns and SRSD, so we are appreciative of that!
- In the process of the STOP ACT Grant (Tim and Rick are working on this) – referencing our DFC work for this grant to apply for the underage drinking prevention (Buyer Beware; Liquor Enforcement relationship; Town Hall forums); 50k/yr x 4 years

PARTNER UPDATES: 9:45am

- **Hampstead School** – completed a TOT with Anne Duckless for NAMI Suicide Prevention
- **SRDS – MTSS** – looking at what the data is showing – have been working with their counselors, looking at the groups they will offer, their crisis plan, and suicide prevention to support SEL for their students
- **SRMS – Youth In Action middle school group** – looking to bring in Arrive Alive for next year; the group membership grew this year; potentially with join the groups next year
- **TRSD** – Tim and Kelley did suicide prevention training for approx. 500 district folks – highlighted 988; more Life of an Owl connections to be made between high school and middle school students
- **CLM** – young adult programs are growing- for ages 16-26 so they don't have to transition straight to adults at 18; have done

some training in First Episode Psychosis; increase in SUD (mushrooms); also opened Jean's Place – for folks who are transitioning and need a place to stay

- **Rick Frost** – concerns about the messaging for psilocybins (mushrooms); the new agency they will be working with is the NH State Police (who the MOU will need to comply with); Rick is also working on Phase 3 for messaging in communities
- **Angels of Addiction** – trying to arrange an exhibit at the Currier; AnnMarie has painted over 300 portraits – talking with libraries and Logan Airport as potential display venues; perhaps could be paired with 988 info
- **Beacon** – Project Echo is still running – tele mentoring
- **TRHS** – may have some kids interested in attending NH Teen Institute; Governors Youth Advisory is meeting on 6/18/22; Fatal Reality went over well – great job by the kids!!
- **AFSP** – Volunteer Fair 6/18/22; also Shamera just promoted to Director and will be bringing on a Programs Manager and a Fundraising Manager (who will be the active members with SoRock); walk has raised 1million mark so this will be highly celebrated – the walk will take place 9/17/22; perhaps SoRock can gather a group to walk “SoRock Walks”
